Speaking Notes - Cadet Sunday

Cadets is a ministry where the counselor's mission statement is "helping boys grow more Christlike in all areas of life." Through relationships with the counselors, the boys are able to develop not just devotionally, but also physically, mentally and socially. Cadets are growing into Christian men, empowered to serve in God's kingdom wherever they may be called.

Optional: Have all of the men and boys in the congregation, who have ever been a cadet or counselor, stand. If your church has had a Cadet club for a number of years this may be a large number of people, likely many of them having leadership roles in the church. Acknowledge that the boys standing at the front with you this year are the leaders of the church in the future.

Cadets is an independent ministry and does not receive guidance from any denomination, nor do they receive funding from any denomination. The offering today is for the Cadet head office, to help them continue supporting the ministry with the development of curriculum and program materials, training opportunities, and guidance.
